

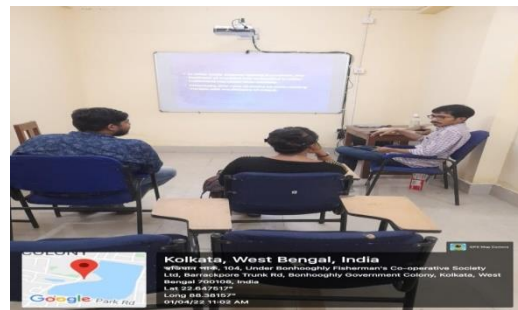

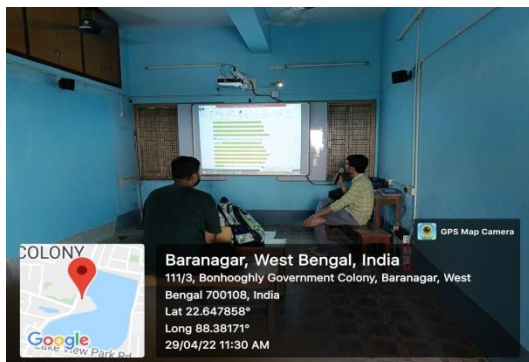

Department of English (Virtual Classroom)



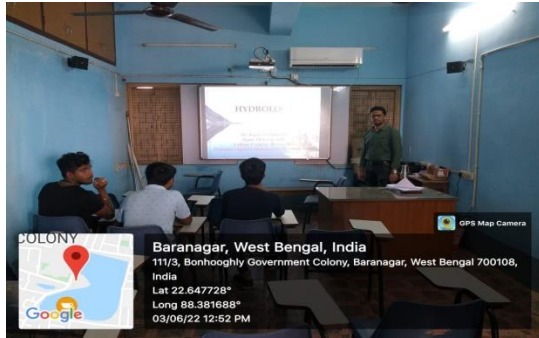

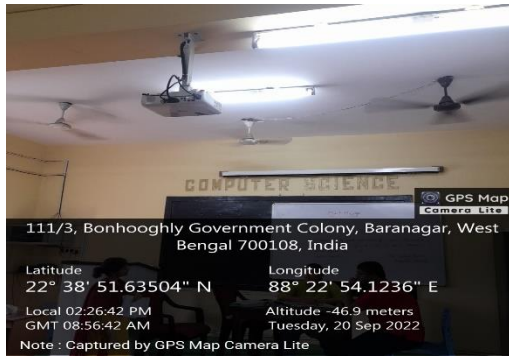
