

COVID 19 Pandemic

- 31 December 2019 China reported to the WHO a cluster of viral pneumonia cases of unknown cause in Wuhan.
- 30 January 2020 WHO declared the outbreak a Public Health Emergency of International Concern.
- Several early infected had visited <u>Huanan</u> Seafood Wholesale Market; the virus is therefore thought to be of zoonotic origin.
- 11 March 2020 WHO recognized the spread of COVID-19 as a pandemic.
- As of 1 July 2020, more than 10.4 million cases of COVID-19 have been reported in more than 188 countries and territories, resulting in more than 511,000 deaths; more than 5.37 million people have recovered.


