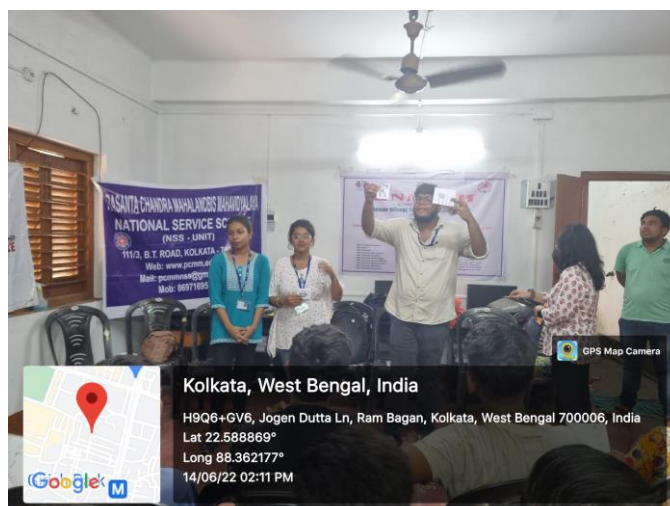

Brief Description of the Value Added Course	<p>The Value Added Course on Gender Sensitization was introduced for Undergraduate students of all Departments. The registration for the course commenced on 20.07.2022.</p> <p>30 students registered for the course from Semester III Honours.</p> <p>The objective of the course was to introduce students to the basic concept of 'gender sensitization' and its applicability in daily life and to develop a rational outlook towards various gender issues to help them become responsible citizens.</p> <p>The course consisted of two modules namely–Sex, Gender and Sexuality (20 hrs.): Introduction to debates on the social construction of sex and gender; Cultural construction of masculinity and femininity; Understanding sexual preference as a right. Gender Rights and the Law (10 hrs.): Women's Rights in Indian Constitution: Fundamental rights and Directive Principles; Right to property; Personal laws; Violence against women; Sexual harassment; Rape; Domestic violence.</p>

The classes were held regularly for one month. The classes were taken by Dr Sukanta Das, Associate Professor and HOD, Department of English, Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Mahavidyalaya; Ms Nandita Bhaumik Chowdhury, SACT, Department of English, Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Mahavidyalaya; Dr Sreyasi Chatterjee, Assistant Professor and HOD, Department of Sociology, Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Mahavidyalaya; Mr Debadyuti Karmakar, Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology, Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Mahavidyalaya.

The evaluation for this course was conducted through a term paper of 20 marks; a written test of 20 marks and a viva-voce of 10 marks.

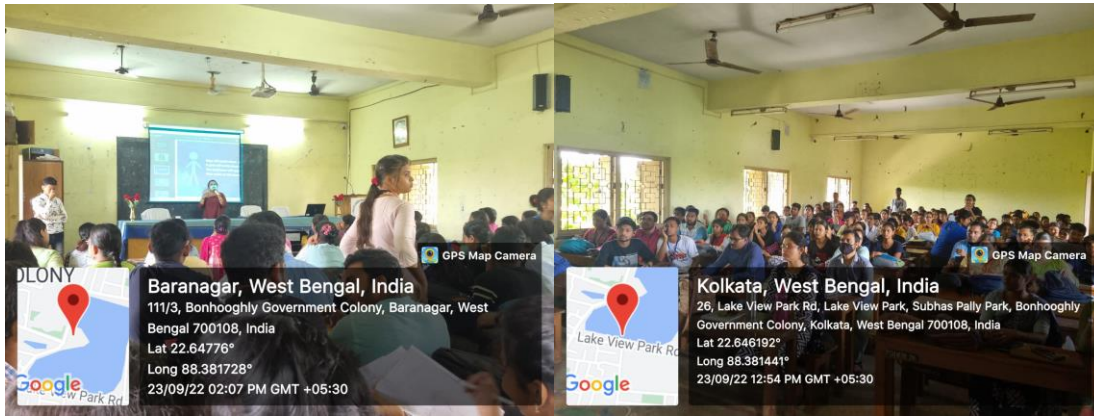

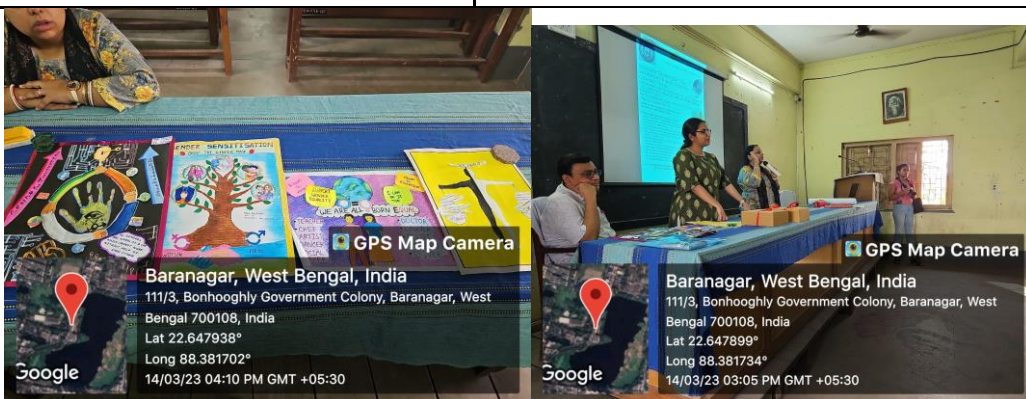
