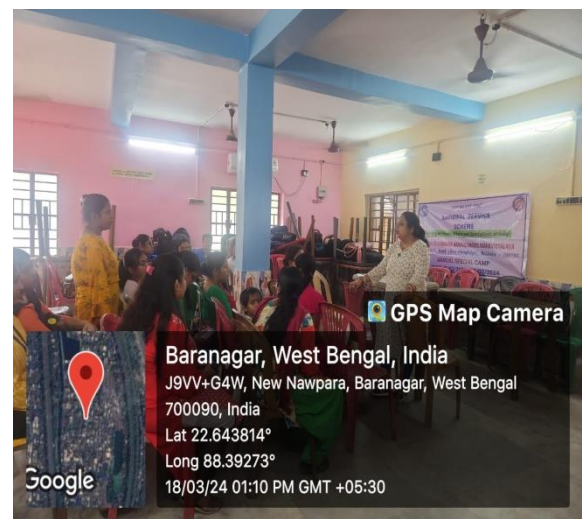
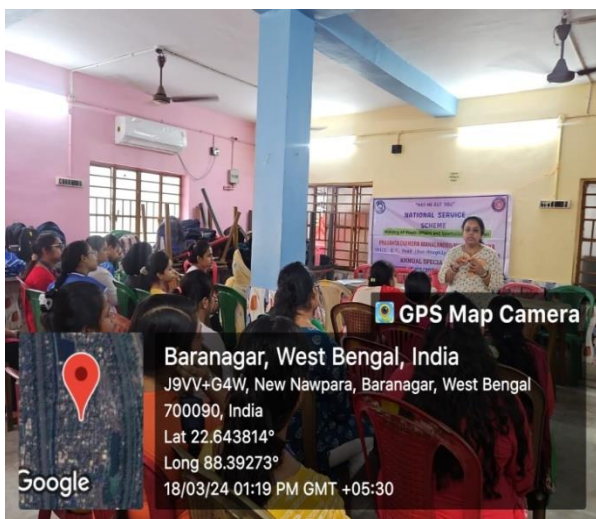
2. Socio-Economic Survey:

camp was to provide accessible eye care services to the underprivileged residents of the slum, identify vision-related issues, and raise awareness about eye health. Prior to the camp, volunteers conducted door-to-door visits to inform residents about the upcoming eye check-up camp, encouraging them to participate and avail themselves of the free services. On the designated day, the eye check-up camp was set up at a central location within the slum area. Residents were registered upon arrival, and then underwent a series of vision tests conducted by trained optometrists and ophthalmologists. Various eye conditions such as refractive errors, cataracts, and other ocular abnormalities were diagnosed. A total of 45 individuals from the adopted slum area participated in the eye check-up camp and two faculty members with 50 NSS Volunteers were actively participated on this Eye Check-up Camp.

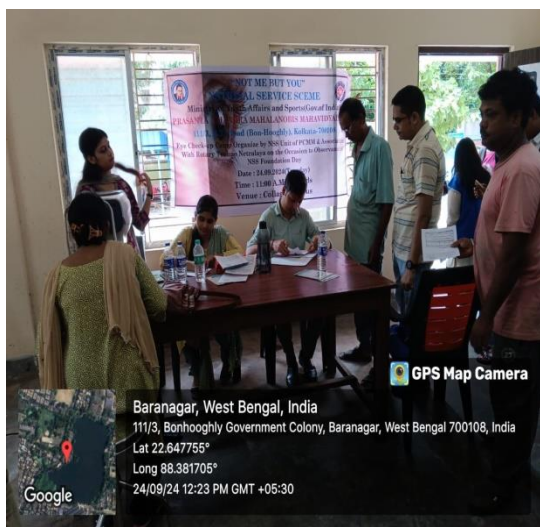
2. Poster Competition:
