

PTM organised by Department Of Bengali on 26.07.2023








#### PRAGATI: Pre Puja Exhibition cum sale on 04.10.2023

#### SPECTRUM wall magazine of the Department of chemistry on 17.10.2023





participate in various events. An interactive session was also held to exchange ideas and view points about voting and individuals right to vote.




Republic Day Celebration on 26.01.2024

## Community Extension work and health assessment of primary school children by SEM-IV Honours students of Food and Nutrition department on 15.04.2024








## Shakespeare in Bollywood Maqbool presented by the Department of English on 23.04,2024


**International Yoga Day Celebration on 21.06.2024**
