

## **Result Analysis of Third (Final) Year / End semester i.e. Semester VI**

**2018-19**

This was the last year of 1+1+1 annual system of bachelor degree course. Students of Honours Course scored fair and on an average 66% of the students successfully completed their Bachelor's degree with Honours. However, in some of the subjects of Honours course students did not score well. In general (pass) course, BA-63% and in B.Sc.- 85% qualified. However qualification percentage of the students of B.Com General is poor. Only 11% of the examinees qualified in the examination. Almost all of the students failed in Corporate Accounting.

It is found that most of the students of general Course (Except students of B.Sc.) are engaged in petty jobs to support their family and were irregular in the class. In B.Com course Corporate Accounting paper is tougher compared to other papers as it is based on New Companies' Act, 2013. There is lack of proper text book in the market written according to their syllabus..

### **Action Taken Report:**

- Failed students are asked to attend special remedial classes taught by the teachers in their off period. (some students have attended).
- Solving of past university examination papers and consult with the teachers with the problems.
- For the next batch we have repetitively warned them about this matter and asked them to follow the classes regularly.
