Result Analysis of Third (Final) Year / End semester i.e. Semester VI)

<u>2019-20</u>

This is the 1st year of outgoing students of Semester VI who studied in CBCS pattern. Here the students scored well as their syllabus and examination system was changed from annual system to 6- month semesters. 33.33% marks were allotted in internal assessment and for the first-time marks were awarded for class attendance. Instead of a paper of 100 marks they had to appear a paper of 50 marks in the final examination and this reduced the burden of pressure in examination hall. So, the students scored well and more than 93% qualified in the examination.

Action Taken Report:

- Students are continuously monitored so that they attend the classes regularly and appear at all types of internal assessment which consists of cumulative assessment of class responses, class tests, projects and semester end tests.
- They were guided properly to take the external assessment more effectively.
- Mentor-mentee classes helped the students to overcome their problems both educational and non-educational.
- More interactive learning is emphasized. Students were guided for preparing good project reports which helped them to score good in internal examination and thereby helped them to attain a good percentage in total marks.
