

Result Analysis of Third (Final) Year / End semester i.e. Semester VI

2022-23:

After the end of pandemic, the students appeared in the examination in normal pen and paper mode. It is seen that the students of programme/general course have shown a very poor performance (In B.A. 19%, in B.Sc.-40% and in B. Com. 24% cleared the semester). However, the students of Honours course more or less retained their earlier examination performance status barring in some subjects. A meticulous analysis found that many students mostly students of General course did not study at all and also were very irregular in attendance and were engaged in petty jobs in order to support their family. Interaction with them revealed that their family's financial condition deteriorated during the pandemic and they had to engage in some work. They appeared at the examination with a pre conceived notion that they will be favoured by the University like that in the pandemic period.

Action Taken Report:

- Motivate them to attend classes.
- Continuous mentoring of the students
- Provide them with study materials
- Continuous internal evaluation in different forms
- One to one interaction to guide them to keep a balance between their job and study.
- Keep an eye so that no one is dropped out of the system.
